## I. Instructions

- 1. Complete all applicable required courses (see the course list below)
- 2. If you do not have a CITI account log into CITI (<a href="www.citiprogram.org">www.citiprogram.org</a>) and click Register. First Question Select your Organization Affiliation start typing "Trinity Health of New York". Agree to the terms and service and continue to create a username and password.
- 3. If you have completed CITI courses with another institution, the courses can be transferred to SJH. After you log-in, add "**Trinity Health of New York**" to your affiliations by clicking the *Add Affiliation* box next to "Would you like to affiliate with another institution?" under your Institutional Courses.
- 4. Training expires in a certain number of years (see specific course for details). You will receive an email from CITI approximately 3 months prior to expiration with directions on completing the required education requirements.
- 5. If you have two CITI account and would like to merge them, please send an email to <a href="mailto:support@citi.org">support@citi.org</a> and provide them with the CITI member number of the account you want to keep and the CITI member number that you would like to merge.

## II. What research education/training programs are you required to complete?

- Human Subjects Research (G1A): required by <u>all</u> individuals participating in human subjects research. (expires in 4 years)
- Responsible Conduct of Research (G1A): required by <u>all</u> individuals participating in human subjects research. (expires in 4 years)
- Conflict of Interest Course (G1A): required for all funded research. (expires in 4 years)
- Good Clinical Practice (G1A): required by all individuals participating in clinical trial research. (expires in 3 years)
  - IRB Members are required to complete all the courses indicated above.
